Eligibility:

Collegiate Division: students enrolled in an undergraduate program as of January, 2010, who are residents of Rutherford County, Tennessee, or who attend a college or university in Rutherford County.

Junior Division: students in enrolled in grades 7 through 12 or equivalent as of January, 2010, who are residents of Rutherford County, Tennessee, who attend a school in Rutherford County, or are members of the Murfreesboro Youth Orchestra.

Instruments/Voice Ranges: All voice ranges, all orchestral and band instruments, guitar, piano.

Required Repertoire for both Collegiate and Junior Divisions: All competition repertoire is to be drawn from the works of Johann Sebastian Bach or other Baroque composers.

Vocalists: An aria for accompanied solo voice from the works of J.S. Bach, for example drawn from cantatas, passions, oratorios or independent arias, or a similar work by a Baroque composer

Pianists: A movement drawn from solo keyboard works of J.S. Bach, for example, works from the *Well-Tempered Clavier*, solo suites, sonatas, partitas, toccatas, keyboard sinfonias, inventions or the Italian Concerto, or a similar work by a Baroque composer.

Instrumentalists: A movement, with or without accompaniment, drawn from suites, sonatas, partitas or comparable music or one concerto movement for solo instrument with orchestra by J.S. Bach, or a similar work by a Baroque composer.

Memorization is not required.

Accompanists:

For the competition and concert: Contestants may provide their own accompanist, or if needed, an accompanist will be provided for an additional fee of \$35

To apply: Submit the competition entry form that accompanies this announcement by March 26, 2010, by mail or e-mail and submit the \$20 entry fee by the competition date using the instructions on the entry form.
